Miami Dade College uses the minimum scores, credits, and guidelines for awarding credit for exams established by the State of Florida's Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC). The chart below indicates how DSST credit will be utilized at MDC. Students transferring to a public senior institution within the State are assured that DSST credit will transfer when earned as a part of a completed Associate in Arts degree. However, it is the student's responsibility to contact the senior institution if any question exists concerning the acceptance of DSST scores.
